Title. 1. Short Title. 2. Amending section 20 of Cook Islands Amendment 1946 (as to constitution of Native Appellate Court).

An Acr to amend the Cook Islands Act, 1915. [6th September, 1948

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Cook Islands Short Title. Amendment Act, 1948, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Cook Islands Act, 1915 (herein- See Reprint after referred to as the principal Act).

2. Section twenty of the Cook Islands Amendment Amending Act, 1946, is hereby amended by repealing subsection section 20 of Cook Islands four, and substituting the following new subsection: Amendment

"(4) The presiding Judge at any sitting of the Act, 1946 (as to Native Appellate Court shall be the Chief Judge of Native the Native Land Court of the Cook Islands, if present, Appellate Court). and in his absence the Chief Judge of the Maori Land 1946, No. 30 Court of New Zealand, if present, and in the absence of both of those Judges the senior Judge of the Native Land Court of the Cook Islands present."
