An Act to amend the Arbitration Amendment Act 2014

The Parliament of the Cook Islands enacts as follows-

1 Title

This Act is the Arbitration Amendment (No.2) Act 2014.

2 Commencement

- (1) This Act comes into force on the day after the day on which it receives the assent of the Queen's Representative.
- (2) Despite subsection (1) section 5 is deemed to have come into force on 9th April 2014.

3 Principal Act amended

This Act amends the Arbitration Amendment Act 2014.

4 Section 1 amended

(1) Section 1 is amended by substituting the following section:

"Title

This Act is the Arbitration Act 2014."

(2) For the avoidance of doubt, a reference to the Arbitration Amendment Act 2014 in an enactment or arbitration agreement whether made before or after the commencement of this Act is a reference to the Arbitration Act 2014.

5 Section 19 amended

Section 19 is repealed and the following section is substituted-

"Arbitration Act 2009 repealed

- "(1) The Arbitration Act 2009 is repealed.
- "(2) For the avoidance of doubt, the enactments specified in Schedule 5 cease to have effect as part of the law of the Cook Islands."
