MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN - We, Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Legislative Assembly of the Cook Islands towards making good the supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this year, have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sums hereinafter mentioned and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted: And be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Cook Islands in Session assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Short Title This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Amendment Act 1980-81 and should be read together with and deemed part of the Appropriation Act 1980 (hereinafter referred to as "principal Act").
- Grant and appropriation of \$14,102,900 out of the Cook Islands Government Account - Subsection (1) of section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the amount of \$13,216,200 and substituting the amount of \$14,102,900.
- Schedule The principal Act is hereby further amended by omitting the Schedule and substituting the following Schedule.
