An Act to Amend the Civil List Ordinance 1965 removing Anomalies with regard to Members of the Legislative Assembly who are employed in the Cook Islands Public Service. (14 January 1966

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of the Cook Islands in Session assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1. Short Title and Commencement -
- (1) This Act may be cited as the Civil List Ordinance Amendment Act 1965.
- (2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 4th day of August 1965.

2. Act to be Read with Civil List Ordinance - This Act shall be read together with and deemed part of the Civil List Ordinance 1965. (In this Act referred to as the Ordinance).

3. <u>Public Service Employees</u> - Section 10 of the Ordinance is hereby amended:

- (a) By inserting after the word "Minister" in line two the words "or an employee of the Cook Islands Public Service".
- (b) By adding after subsection(2) the following subsection:

"(3) Nothing in the Cook Islands Public Service Regulations 1964 shall apply with respect to any payment made under this Ordinance to an employee of the Cook Islands Public Service who is a member of the Assembly".

- (1) Section 55 of the Cook Islands Amendment Act 1964 is hereby repealed.
  - (2) Such repeal shall take effect as the 4th day of August 1965 and all payments requiring adjustment as a result of the provisions of this Act shall be adjusted accordingly.
