## An Act to amend the Public Service Act 1975

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of the Cook Islands in Session assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

- 1. Short Title and Commencement (1) This Act may be cited \*as the Public Service Amendment (No. 2) Act 1991 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Public Service Act 1975 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").
- (2) This Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed by the Minister and notified by publication in the Gazette.
- 2. <u>Interpretation</u> Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the definition of "Employee" and replacing it by the following definition:

""Employee", in relation to the Public Service, unless specified otherwise in any applicable enactment, means a person employed in any Ministry of State or Government body, whether an ad-hoc body, department, board, or other organisation created by enactment, whether on the permanent staff (including any probationer) or occupying from time to time a term or temporary position, or whether the employee is a wage worker or an expatriate."

3. Application - The principal Act is amended by adding thereto the following section:

"2A. Application - The provisions of this Act shall apply to Employees, except when at variance with a more specific applicable enactment.'
