Regulations

- Title**
These regulations are the COVID-19 (Public Health Measures) Amendment Regulations 2022.
- Commencement**
These regulations come into force on the day after they are made.

3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the COVID-19 (Public Health Measures) Regulations 2021 (the **principal regulations**).

4 Regulation 24 (Travel to Pa Enea (except Aitutaki))

(1) Regulation 24 (c) is amended by omitting “Rarotonga” and substituting “the Cook Islands”.

(2) Regulation 24 is amended by inserting the following paragraph after sub clause (c):

“(i) to prove that the travel requirement in sub clause (c) is met, on the day of departure a person must provide a signed declaration to that effect in a form approved by the Secretary.”
