REGULATIONS

1. Title - These Regulations may be cited as the Customs Amendment (Overtime) Regulations 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Regulations 1959 (N.Z.S.R. 1959/93) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").

2. Overtime - (1) Regulation 13(1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) the expression "\$10.08" and substituting it with the expression \$15.12.

(2) Regulations 13(1) of the principal regulation is hereby further amended by omitting from paragraph (B) the expression "\$7.53" and substituting it with the expression \$11.30.

3. Fees for Officer's time - Regulations 14(1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$5.03" and substituting it with the expression \$7.55.
