ORDER

- 1. Title This Order may be cited as the Commission of Inquiry (Patrol Boat "Te Kukupa") Amendment Order 1990 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Commission of Inquiry (Patrol Boat "Te Kukupa") Amendment Order 1990 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).
- 2. Terms of Reference Section 3 of the principal Order is hereby amended by adding after paragraph (b) the following paragraphs:

- (a) Determine what the roles of the Patrol Boat "Te Kukupa" should be;
- (b) Determine the most effective and efficient way in which the vessel should be administered with clearly delineated responsibilities together with an organization chart and a work-plan chart;
- (c) Determine in terms of the Marine Board classifications, what catergory the Patrol Boat would most appropriately fall under and thereby determine the adequacy or otherwise of the crew's qualifications for certification with such a classification;
- (d) Determine whether the vessel should carry cargo and if so, what kind and under what conditions as well as under whose instructions;
- (e) Determine whether the vessel should be carrying other government officials, under what condition and under whose instructions.
