Regulations

- 1 **Title**
These regulations are the Development Investment Amendment Regulations 2019.
- 2 **Commencement**
 - (1) These regulations (except regulation 7) come into force on the day after the date on which these regulations are made.
 - (2) Regulation 7 comes into force on 1 January 2020.

- 3 **Principal regulations amended**
These regulations amend the Development Investment Regulations 1996 (the **principal regulations**).
