1. Title - These Regulations may be cited as the Marriage Amendment Regulations 1990, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Marriage Regulations 1975 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").

2. New scale of fees substituted - The principal Regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule thereto, and substituting it with the Schedule as set out in these Regulations.

"SECOND SCHEDULEFees to be paid to the Registrar-General and to Registrars  
Under the Marriage Act 1973

For every notice of a marriage intended to be solemnised by officiating minister under section 23 of the Act	20
For every marriage solemnised by a Registrar (including certified copy of the entry in the register book if that certificate is issued at the time of solemnisation)	50
Additional fee in respect of a marriage solemnised by a Registrar whose office is not at the time ordinarily open for the transaction of public business under the Act	30
For every caveat entered	40
For every certified copy of an entry in a Registrar's marriage register book (other than for a certificate issued at the time of solemnisation) and for every certified copy of an entry in the records of the office of the Registrar-General (when correct year given)	10
Search or inspection of marriage notice books or Registrar's marriage register book, in respect of each name or entry searched or inspected when correct year given	2
Search in any index or marriage records in the office of the Registrar-General, in respect of each name or entry searched:	
For every year of search requested	1
Verification of items in a marriage entry, per item	1
