1	Title These regulations are the Money-Changing and Remittance Businesses Amendment Regulations 2014.
2	Commencement These regulations are deemed to have come into force on 1 May 2014.
3	Fees For the purposes of section 15 the fees payable are specified in the Schedule to these Regulations.

4 Security bond

For the purposes of section 25 an amount of \$10,000 is prescribed.

5 Repeals

The Money-Changing and Remittance Businesses Regulations 2010 is repealed.
