KING'S REGULATION

TO AMEND REGULATION No. 6 OF 1897 PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION OF BILLS OF SALE.

- Made by His Britannic Majesty's Acting High Commissioner for the Western Pacific in accordance with the provisions of the Pacific Order in Council, 1893.
 - In the name of His Majesty, George the Fifth, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India.

1. This Regulation may be cited for all purposes as the Bills of Short title. Sale Registration (Amendment) Regulation 1915.

2. Section eleven of Queen's Regulation No. 6 of 1897 is hereby Amendment of amended by the addition at the end thereof of the following proviso: section 11 of Regulation 6 of 1897.

"Provided that in the District of Tonga there shall be sub-offices

"in the Haabai Group and the Vavau Group at which registra-"tion shall be effected of Bills of Sale relating to goods situated

" in those groups respectively."

3. Any registration effected in the office of the Deputy Com-Validation of missioner of Haabai before the coming into force of this Regulation registration at Haabai. shall be deemed to be a good and valid registration for all purposes.

4. Schedule A to Regulation 6 of 1897 is hereby repealed and the Amendment of Schedule A. following substituted therefor :-
