KING'S REGULATION

TO AMEND THE EXPORTS AND IMPORTS REGULATION
1920.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the
Western Pacific under the provisions of the Pacific Order in
Council 1893.

In the name of His Majesty, GEORGE THE FIFTH, by the Grace of
God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland
and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender
of the Faith, Emperor of India.

1. This Regulation may be cited for all purposes as the Exports and Imports (Amendment) Regulation 1920. SHORT TITLE
2. The Exports and Imports Regulation 1920 (hereinafter called the principal Regulation) is hereby amended and shall be construed and have effect as if the following section had been contained in the principal Regulation at the date of its publication:— AMENDMENT OF
KING'S

NO. 3 OF 1920.
- “ 4. This Regulation shall remain in force for three years from the tenth day of January one thousand nine hundred and twenty.” LIMITATION OF
EFFECT.
