KING'S REGULATION

TO AMEND THE SOLOMONS LICENCE REGULATION,
1916.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the
Western Pacific under the provisions of the Pacific Order in
Council 1893.

In the name of His Majesty GEORGE THE FIFTH, by the Grace of
God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland
and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender
of the Faith, Emperor of India.

1. This Regulation may be cited for all purposes as the Solomons SHORT TITLE.
Licence Amendment Regulation, 1923.

Solomons Licence Amendment Regulation, 1923.

" Provided that when a vessel is employed in trading solely as a common carrier the person so employing such vessel shall in lieu of the licence fees in this subhead specified pay the sum of fifteen pounds for every entry of any such vessel.

" (v) Employing or using vessel (other

" than a passenger steamer in respect of which a trading licence has been taken out) for recruiting labour in, or returning labour to the Protectorate—

" For every ton of tonnage

" The licence under this subhead may be issued quarterly, expiring on the 31st March, 30th June, 30th September, and 31st December at one-half the fee payable for one-half year.

" Provided that the licence fee payable in

" exceed year .. 150 0 0

" and in the case of a quarterly licence half-year .. 80 0 0

REPEAL.

3. Section 5 of the Solomons Licence Amendment Regulation, 1918, and the Solomons Licence Amendment Regulation, 1920, are hereby repealed.
