## AN ACT

### FOR AN ACT TO AMEND THE PRESCRIPTION OF SALARIES ACT

ENACTED by the Parliament of Fiji—

*Short title*

1. This Act may be cited as the Prescription of Salaries (Amendment) Act 1998.

*Interpretation*

2. In this Act, "Principal Act" means the Prescription of Salaries Act (Cap. 2).

*Commencement*

3.—(1) Subject to subsections (2) and (3), this Act comes into operation on the date of publication in the Gazette.

(2) Section 4 is to have effect as if this Act had been published on 1st January 1997.

(3) Section 5 is to have effect as if this Act had been published on 1st January 1998.
