However, if you-Fail to pay the determined penalty; (ii) Intend to contest the proceedings; or (iii) For any other matters, you do not wish to respond to this notice; The Commerce Commission will seek to initiate prosecution and/or legal proceedings against the above-named person or company who committed the offence. Note: section 59(2) of the Decree provides if a person is found guilty by a court a liability for a penalty up to \$15,000 for a natural person or \$20,000 for a body corporate arises. Date:....
