COMPULSORY REGISTRATION OF CUSTOMERS FOR TELEPHONE SERVICES
DECREE 2010
(DECREE NO. 34 OF 2010)

Extension of Deadline for Cancellation of Telephone Communications Services

By virtue of the powers under section 3(5) of the Compulsory Registration of Customers for Telephone Services Decree 2010 ('the Decree'), I hereby extend the time set out in section 3(4) of the Decree within which a service provider must cancel telephone communications services for any land or mobile telephone number which has not been registered under the provisions of the Decree to Monday, 8th November 2010.

Any service provider who, by Monday 8th November 2010, fails to cancel telephone communications services for any land or mobile telephone number which has not been registered under the provisions of the Decree, shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a maximum fine of \$200,000.
