NASINU TRAFFIC REGULATIONS 2010

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Section 113 of the Act, and after consulting the Authority, I make these regulations: -

PART 1-PRELIMINARY

Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the Nasinu Traffic Regulations. 1.

Application

These Regulations apply to all the areas within the Nasinu Town. 2.

Interpretation

- In these regulations, unless the context otherwise required:—
 - "Base" means a specific area allocated and approved by relevant authority where PSV vehicle park and wait for passengers.
 - "Bus" means a public service vehicle constructed or adapted to carry more than fifteen (15) passengers excluding the driver;
 - "Carrier" means a motor vehicle constructed and equipped for the safe carriage of passengers and goods such that the majority of passengers are located separate from the driver's compartment.
 - "Carriageway" means a part of the public street reserved for the movement of vehicles:
 - "Council" means Nasinu Town Council as the local authority responsible for the Nasinu Land Boundary
 - "Footpath" means the part of the public street, provided to be used by pedestrian and includes footpath lane, thoroughfare, or any other part of the street habitually used by pedestrian and not by vehicle;
 - "One-way street" means a public street with carriage way designed or configured for traffic heading one direction;

- "park" or "parking" means the standing of a vehicle whether attended, occupied or otherwise upon a roadway, otherwise then temporarily for the purpose of, or while actually engaged in, loading or unloading merchandise or taking on or discharging passengers;
- "Pedestrian" means a person on foot on a public street and includes a person on a public tricycle, scooter, roller skates, skateboard, any other device designed principally for use for children at play,

Any baby in a pram or a wheel chair;

"Taxi" means a motor vehicle usually fitted with a taximeter that may be hired along with its driver, to carry not more than 4 passengers to any specified destination.

PART 2—TAXIS

Locations of Taxi Stands

4. Schedule 1 set out the areas for taxi stands.

Prohibition on Stopping of Other Vehicles on Taxi Stands

5. No person shall stop or park any vehicle, other than a taxi, on any taxi stand.

Restriction on the Stopping of Taxis

- 6. The driver of a taxi shall not stop or park the taxi on any road or part thereof other than a taxi stand except:—
 - (a) for the purpose of taking on or discharging passengers and their baggage; or
 - (b) while waiting for passengers who shall have engaged such taxi; or
 - (c) while the driver is otherwise attending to the requirements of the hirer of the taxi, and in any such a case to stop, for a period of not more than 15 minutes; or
 - (d) while the driver of a taxi is obtaining a meal.

Restrictions on taxi Drivers at Taxi Stands

7. The driver of a taxi shall not permit such taxi to stand on any taxi stand if the stand is occupied by the required number of vehicles indicated on a traffic sign in relation to that stand.

Taxis to move into vacated Positions

8. When a taxi vacates a position on a taxi stand, the driver of the taxi behind vacating the position shall move the taxi into the vacated position without delay.

Duty of driver to accept engagement

- 9. If a taxi is upon a taxi stand and not already engaged and any person desires to engage it for any reasonable journey, the driver must not refuse such engagement unless:—
 - (a) the acceptance of it shall be impracticable by reason of prior engagement or for any other reasonable cause or

(b) the proposed hirer is exhibiting signs of threatening, uncontrolled, dangerous, undesirable, offensive and other similar behavior and by reason thereof is not in a fit and proper state to be carried as a passenger.

Taxi Fee & Charges Structure

10. The taxi fee structure shall be accordance to that set out in the fourth Schedule.

Base Approval for Council Base

- 11. Base approval for bases managed by the Council shall not be issued unless the base applicant undertakes to:—
 - (a) Pay the base application fee which shall be the first fee to enable the processing of the taxi base application;
 - (b) Pay the base leasing fee which is set out in Schedule 4 to effect base approval for three (3) years;
 - (c) Monthly base service fee shall be charged by the Council for the use of the base and this fee must be paid in advance on a quarterly basis till the end of the base leasing period;
 - (d) Taxi business license fee per annum to be paid at the beginning of each calendar year

Base Approval for Private Base

- 12.—(1) The Base owner of each private base must pay to the Council the Car Park Fees as set out in the schedule;
- (2) Private Bases shall only be renewed annually after the approval by Town Planning Office and also requires the full consideration of the Nasinu Town Council

PART 3-CARRIER

Appointment of Carrier Stops

13. No carrier operation within the routes specified in its Road Route licence shall stop to drop or pick up passengers except at places marked or indicated by the appropriate traffic signs.

Restriction on other vehicles

14. No person shall stop or park any vehicle, other than a carrier, on any carrier stand.

Carrier Stands

15. Schedule 2 sets out the area for carrier stands

Restriction on parking

- 16. The driver of a carrier shall not stop or park the carrier on any road or part thereof other than a carrier stand except:—
 - (a) for the purpose of taking on or discharging passengers and their baggage; or
 - (b) while waiting for passengers who shall have engaged such service; or
 - (c) while the driver is otherwise attending to the requirements of the hirer of the carrier and in any such a case to stop, for a period of not more than 15 minutes; or

(d) while the driver of a carrier is obtaining a meal.

Carrier to move into vacated Positions

17. When a carrier vacates a position on a carrier stand, the driver of the carrier behind vacating the position shall move the carrier into the vacated position without delay.

PART 4-VAN

Appointment of Van Base

18. The Council shall in accordance with this order appoint such locations suitable for the operation of Van.

Restriction on other vehicles

19. No person shall stop or park any vehicle, other than a Van on any Van Stand.

Van Stands

20. Schedule 3 sets out the area for Van stands

Restriction on parking

- 21. The driver of a carrier shall not stop or park the Van on any road or part thereof other than a Van stand except:—
 - (a) for the purpose of taking on or discharging passengers and their baggage; or
 - (b) while waiting for passengers who shall have engaged such service; or
 - (c) while the driver is otherwise attending to the requirements of the hirer of the Van and in any such a case to stop, for a period of not more than 15 minutes;
 - (d) while the driver of a Van is obtaining a meal.

Van to move into vacated Positions

22. When a Van vacates a position on a Van stand, the driver of the Van behind vacating the position shall move the carrier into the vacated position without delay.

Van Fee & Charges Structure

23. The Van fee structure shall be in accordance to that set out in the fourth Schedule.

Base Approval for Council Base

- 24. Base approval for bases managed by the Council shall not be issued unless the base applicant: undertakes to:
 - (a) Pay the base application fee which shall be the first fee to enable the processing of the van base application;
 - (b) Pay the base leasing fee which is set out in Schedule fourth (4) to effect base approval for three (3) years;
 - (c) Monthly base service fee shall be charged by the Council for the use of the base and this fee must be paid in advance on a quarterly basis;
 - (d) Van business license fee per annum to be paid at the beginning of each calendar year

Base Approval for Private Base

25. The Base owner of each private base must pay to the Council the Car Park Fees as set out in the fourth (4) Schedule.

PART 5-STANDS AND PARKING PLACES

Provision for temporary stand

26. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these regulations, at any place where vehicles are assembled any uninformed member of the Fiji Police Force or Authorised Officers may appoint a temporary stand for such vehicles or may class thereof and every person shall work such as directed by such member of the Fiji Police or Authorised officers.

Attendance upon vehicle

- 27. The driver of: -
 - (a) a bus shall be constantly in attendance upon the same while the bus is on any bus stand;
 - (b) a goods vehicle, shall be constantly in attendance upon the same while it is on any goods vehicles between the hours of 6.00 am and 6.00 pm on Monday to Saturday of any week;
 - (c) a taxi, while it is on any taxi stand.

PART 6-ONE-WAY STREETS

Location of One - Way Street

- 28.—(1). The carriageway set out in Schedule 5 shall be one-way streets.
- (2) The driver of a one-way street shall follow the direction specified in Schedule 5.

PART 7—MAXIMUM SPEED

Speed limits

29. The maximum speed at which a vehicle shall be driven in the area within the Nasinu Town boundaries inclusive of the Kings Road is 50 km per hour.

PART 8-EXEMPTIONS

- 30.—(1) The provision of this order shall not apply to the following:—
 - (a) a registered medical practitioner in the course of rendering professional services to any person at any other than his normal place of practice;
 - (b) a police vehicle conveying members of the Fiji Police Force on urgent Police duty;
 - (c) a Fire Brigade vehicle proceeding to any fire alarm of fire; and
 - (d) an ambulance vehicle answering an urgent call or proceeding to hospital with any sick or injured person requiring emergency treatment;

- (e) A driver operating vehicles on the site of road maintenance or construction or maintenance work on power or telephone lines or equipment while engaged on such work;
- (f) A driver operating vehicles in accordance with directions given to them by any uniformed member of the Fiji Police Force or Authorised Officers; and
- (g) A driver operating vehicles engaged in garbage collection or in connection with the installation or maintenance of water services.

Identification Stickers

31. Each registered medical practitioner shall affix and keep affixed to the windscreen of his car the identification sticker supplied by Nasinu Town Council.
