MARITIME TRANSPORT ACT 2013

Maritime (Coasting-trade) (Amendment) Regulations 2021

IN exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 243 of the Maritime Transport Act 2013, I hereby make these Regulations—

Short title and commencement

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Maritime (Coasting-trade) (Amendment) Regulations 2021.

(2) These Regulations are deemed to have come into force on 1 March 2020.

(3) In these Regulations, the Maritime (Coasting-trade) Regulations 2014 is referred to as the “Principal Regulations”.

Regulation 6 amended

2. Regulation 6 of the Principal Regulations is amended by—

(a) deleting subregulation (4) and substituting the following—

“(4) The Licence granted by the Minister shall be valid for a period not exceeding 20 years.”; and

(b) in subregulation (5), deleting “of not more than 5 years” and substituting “not exceeding the duration of a valid Licence issued in accordance with subregulation (4) and section 111 of the Act”.

Schedule amended

3. The Schedule to the Principal Regulations is amended by—

(a) in item 1 after “(per year)” wherever it appears, inserting “or such other fee approved by the Minister”; and

(b) in item 2, deleting “\$5/net tonnage (5 yearly)” and substituting “\$1/net tonnage (per year) or such other fee approved by the Minister”.
