Trade Standards and Quality Control (Prescribed On-Spot Contravention Notice) Regulations 2011

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 60 of the Trade Standards and Quality Control Decree 1992, I hereby make the following Regulations—

Short title and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Trade Standards and Quality Control (Prescribed On-Spot Contravention Notice) Regulations 2011 and come into force upon gazettal.

Prescribed notice

2. For the purpose of section 17(1A) of the Trade Standards and Quality Control Decree 1992, the prescribed notice is in the Schedule.
