KING'S REGULATION

TO AMEND THE LAW RELATING TO COPYRIGHT.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the Western Pacific under the provisions of the Pacific Order in Council, 1893.

In the name of His Majesty, George the Fifth, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India.

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Copyright SHORT TITLE. Amendment Regulation 1918.

2. For the purpose of the application of section fourteen APPLICATION OF of the (Imperial) Copyright Act, 1911, to the importation THE COPYRIGHT into the British Solomon Islands Protectorate of works Act. made out of the Protectorate:-

(1) The Resident Commissioner of the Protectorate shall powers and Outles of perform the duties and may exercise the powers thereby RESIDENT imposed on or given to the Commissioners of Customs and COMMISSIONER. Excise of the United Kingdom.

RECULATIONS TO BE APPROVED BY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.

PROVISION AS TO NOTICES GIVEN TO COMMIS-SIONERS OF CUSTOMS.

SECTION 14 OF THE ACT INCOR-PORATED WITH CUSTOMS REGULATION. REPEAL. (2) Regulations made by the Resident Commissioner under that section shall require the approval of His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the Western Pacific.

(3) Regulations made under that section may provide that notices given to the Commissioners of Customs and Excise of the United Kingdom if communicated by them to the Resident Commissioner shall be deemed to have been given by the owner of the Copyright to the Resident Commissioner.

(4) That section shall have effect as if it formed part of

the Solomons (Customs) Regulation 1907.

3. Sections four and five of the Solomon Islands Copyright Regulation 1917 are hereby repealed.
