KING'S REGULATION

TY. AMEND THE GILBERT AND ELLICE ISLANDS PROTECTORATE (CONSOLIDATION) REGULATION, 1908.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the Western Pacific under the Pacific Order in Council, 1893.

In the name of his Majesty, George the Fifth, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India.

- 1. This Regulation may be cited as the Gilbert and Ellice (Leases short title. Extent) Regulation, 1911.
- 2. Section twenty-four of the Gilbert and Ellice Islands Pro-Amendment of sectectorate (Consolidation) Regulation, 1908, is hereby amended by the tion 24 of Regulation insertion, after the word "nor" in the penultimate line thereof, of the words "without the approval of the High Commissioner."
