KING'S REGULATION

TO AMEND THE SOLOMONS GOVERNMENT CURRENCY NOTES REGULATION 1916.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the Western Pacific under the provisions of the Pacific Order in Council 1893.

In the name of His Majesty George the Fifth, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India.

- 1. This Regulation may be cited as the Government Currency SHORTTHE. Notes (Amendment) Regulation 1923.
- 2. Subsection four of section twelve of the Solomons Currency AMENDMENT OF Notes Regulation 1916 hereinafter called the principal Regulation section 120f is hereby amended and shall be read as if between the words NO.100F1916. "up" and "an" in the third line thereof the words "and publish in the Gazette" were inserted.

3. Subsection six of section twelve of the principal Regulation REPEAL OF is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor: --

SUBSECTION 6 OF AND SUBSTITU-TION OF NEW SUBSECTION.

"(6) The annual statement shall after being audited and 80,10 of 1918 "certified correct be published in the Gazette."
