KING'S REGULATION

TO AMEND THE SOLOMONS (QUARANTINE)
REGULATION 1916.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the Western Pacific under the provisions of the Pacific Order in Council 1893.

In the name of His Majesty, GEORGE THE FIFTH, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India.

1. This Regulation may be cited for all purposes as the Solomons (Quarantine) Amendment Regulation 1920. SHORT TITLE

2. Section eight of the Solomons (Quarantine) Regulation 1916 is hereby amended and shall be read as if the following subsection were added thereto:— AMENDMENT OF SECTION 8 OF REGULATION NO. 3 OF 1916.

“(2) Every person on board any such vessel (unless prevented by illness) who shall fail to appear before the Health Officer at the place and time appointed for inspection shall be guilty of an offence against this Regulation.”
