KING'S REGULATION

TO BRING INTO FORCE THE PROVISIONS OF THE
TONGAN COMPANIES ACT, 1912, AFFECTING BRITISH
SUBJECTS AND FOREIGNERS IN TONGA.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the
Western Pacific under the provisions of the Pacific Order in
Council, 1893.

In the name of His Majesty, George the Fifth, by the Grace of God
of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the
British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith,
Emperor of India.

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Tongan Companies Act, Short title.
1912, Operation Regulation, 1913.

2. The provisions of the Act of the Parliament of Tonga No. Operation of the
XIX. of 1912, shortly entitled the Companies Act, 1912, so far as Tongan Companies
they extend to and affect British subjects and foreigners within Act, 1912, regarding
the Kingdom of Tonga are hereby declared to be in force therein British subjects and
and shall be administered according to the provisions of the Pacific foreigners in Tonga.
