AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$47,110 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1995, for the purpose of paying costs in connection with the National and State Energy Conference and fuel contract negotiations, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$47,110, or so much thereof as may be 2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the 3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending 4 September 30, 1995, for the purpose of paying costs in connection 5 with the National and State Energy Conference and fuel contract 6 negotiations.

7 Section 2. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with 8 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial 9 Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be the President of the 10 11 Federated States of Micronesia or the President's designee. The 12 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so 13 much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess 14 15 of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottee to obligate 16 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1995. 17 18 19 20 21
