CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 10-2, C.D.1, C.D.2, C.D.3, C.D.4, C.D.5, C.D.6, C.D.7 **PUBLIC LAW NO. 10-24**

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$29,402,695 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, for the operations of the executive branch, legislative branch, judicial branch, Public Auditor, agencies of the National Government, and for special programs, grants, subsidies, contributions, and refunds of the National Government during fiscal year 1998; to establish a budget for Compact sections 214(b), 215(a)(2), 216(a)(2), 216(a)(3), and 221(b) and to appropriate special funds available therefor under the Compact; to establish a development budget and to appropriate funds available therefor under the Compact; to establish employment ceilings; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch. The sum of \$12,473,860, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, for the operations of the Executive Branch of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1998. Of the total funds appropriated under this section, \$519,000 shall be deemed to come from the funds available under section 216(a)(1) of the Compact of Free Association. The sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

Section 6. Energy budget. The sum of \$-0-, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, to pay utility bills for National Government offices, operate and maintain standby generators, and establish energy conservation programs, including the purchase and installation of energy efficient air conditioners and other appliances for National Government buildings. The funds appropriated under this section shall be deemed to come from the funds available under section 214(b) of the Compact of Free Association.

Section 7. Operating expenses of the Telecommunications Corporation. The sum of \$882,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from

the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, for the operations of the Telecommunications Corporation of the Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1998. The funds appropriated under this section shall be deemed to come from the funds available under section 215(a)(2) of the Compact of Free Association.

Section 8. Compact section 216(a)(2) programs. Section 13. Develo	opment budget - Appropriation. The sum of \$2,180,0	000, or so

Section 13. <u>Development budget - Appropriation</u>. The sum of \$2,180,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, for capital improvement and development programs and projects of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1998. Of the funds appropriated under this section, \$1,436,192 (for lines (1), (3) and (4)) shall be deemed to come from the capital account of the Compact of Free Association. The sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

(2) The number of positions authorized applies individually to each of the departments and offices of the Executive and Legislative Branches, the National Judiciary, the Public Auditor, and to the agencies as provided in subsection (1) of this section, except that the President may transfer up to 12 positions between the departments and offices of the executive branch. This authorization of positions covers all permanent employees and all contract personnel whose employment extends for more than 90 days. No funds may be expended for unbudgeted positions.

Section 15. Reprogramming.

- (1) The President may reprogram up to 10 percent to and from the funds appropriated to each department and office in section 1. The President or his designee may reprogram up to 15 percent to and from the funds appropriated to any division, and may reprogram up to 15 percent to and from each line within the budget of a division, within a department or office or its functional equivalent.
- (2) The Speaker or his designee may reprogram up to 10 percent to and from the funds appropriated to each of the subsections in section 2, and may reprogram up to 15 percent to and from the funds appropriated in each of the lines within the subsections of section 2.
- (3) The Chief Justice or his designee may reprogram up to 15 percent to and from the funds appropriated in each of the lines in section 3.
- (4) The Public Auditor may reprogram up to 15 percent to and from the funds appropriated in each of the lines in section 4.
- (5) Allottees of funds may reprogram up to 15 percent to and from the funds appropriated in each of the lines within the subsections of section 5.
- (6) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections (1) through (5) of this section, no funds may be reprogrammed to or from any personnel account (except as necessary in conjunction with a position transfer permitted under section 14(2) of this act) or subparagraph (a)(iii) of subsection (12) of section 1 of this act.

Section 16. Allotment and management of funds and lapse

date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979; PROVIDED, however, that the allottee of the funds

under section 7 of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Transportation and Communication; and PROVIDED FURTHER that the funds appropriated to Chuuk State under subsection (3) of section 10 of this act shall be retained in the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia until a scholarship recipient is identified to the President or the President's designee, at which time scholarship funds in the amount of the scholarship award shall be disbursed directly to the educational institution in the form of a two-party check payable to both the scholarship recipient and the educational institution he or she is attending; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottee for the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(m)(ii) of section 11 of this act shall be Micronesian Legal Services Corporation; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottees for the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(o) of section 11 of this act shall be the Governors of the respective States, and no funds appropriated under subsection (2)(o) of section 11 of this act shall be disbursed from the General Fund to the allottees unless the President certifies that the State involved has entered into a joint law enforcement agreement for the period of October 1, 1997, to September 30, 1998, with the National Government pursuant to chapter 12 of the title 12 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottees for the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(s) of section 11 of this act shall be the Chief Justices of the respective States; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (2)(ii) of section 11 of this act shall be the President of the College of Micronesia - FSM, who shall not authorize release of funds to be used on behalf of a student until the President is satisfied that the student has exhausted all other sources of financial assistance; and PROVIDED FURTHER, that the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1) of section 13 shall be the Director of the Office of Administrative Services. Each allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 1998; PROVIDED, however, that the authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by sections 7, 9, 10, 11(2)(w), 11(2)(ff) and 13 shall not lapse.

Section 17. <u>Effective date</u>. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
