

Public Law No. 11-79

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 11-59, as amended by Public Law No. 11-69, by further amending sections 1 and 3, as amended by Public Law No. 11-69, to re-appropriate funds previously line-item vetoed; by further amending section 7, as amended by Public Law No. 11-69, to change an allottee for certain Kosrae State funds; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 11-59, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 11-69, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. The sum of \$350,000, or so much thereof as may
4 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
5 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
6 September 30, 2001, to provide funds for infrastructure and
7 other projects and programs in the State of Kosrae. The
8 funds appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as
9 follows:

19 Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 11-59, as amended by
20 Public Law No. 11-69, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

21 "Section 3. The sum of \$2,100,000, or so much thereof as may
22 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
23 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
24 September 30, 2001, to provide funds for infrastructure and
25 other projects and programs in the State of Chuuk. The funds

5 Section 3. Section 7 of Public Law No. 11-59, as amended by
6 Public Law No. 11-69, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

7 "Section 7. Allotment and management of fund and lapse date.

8 (1) All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
9 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with
10 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
11 Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds
12 appropriated under subsections (1), (2), (4), (5) and (10) of
13 section 1 of this act shall be the Secretary of the
14 Department of Finance and Administration, or his designee.
15 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (3)
16 of section 1 and the funds appropriated under section 6 of
17 this act shall be the Governor of the State of Kosrae, or his
18 designee. The allottees of the funds appropriated under
19 subsections (6) through (9) of section 1 of this act shall be
20 the Mayors of the respective towns or municipalities. The
21 allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 2 and 5 of
22 this act shall be the President of the Federated States of
23 Micronesia, or his designee. The allottee of the funds
24 appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the Chuuk
25 State Commission on Improvement Projects; EXCEPT THAT the

1 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (6)(d) of
2 section 3 of this act shall be the Northwest Project
3 Coordinator. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
4 subsections (1) through (13) of section 4 of this act shall
5 be the Governor of the State of Yap, or his designee. The
6 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (14) of
7 section 4 of this act shall be the Speaker of the Congress of
8 the Federated States of Micronesia, or his designee. The
9 allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that the funds
10 appropriated by this act, or so much thereof as may be
11 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this
12 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the
13 sum appropriated.

14 (2) The authority of the allottees to obligate funds
15 appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30,
16 2002; EXCEPT THAT the authority of the allottee to obligate
17 funds appropriated under subsection (10) of section 1 of this
18 act shall not lapse."

19 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
20 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
21 law without such approval.
