

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 10-120, as amended, by amending section 1 thereof to reallocate certain funds previously appropriated for Election District No. 3 in the State of Chuuk, by amending section 6 thereof accordingly, by further amending section 6 to change the allottee of funds previously appropriated for Election District No. 1 in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 10-120, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 10-122, 10-144, 11-8, 11-20, 11-32, 12-6, 12-20,  
3 and 12-68, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof  
5 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the  
6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for  
7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999, for the  
8 purpose of funding infrastructure and other projects and  
9 programs in the State of Chuuk. The funds appropriated  
10 under this section shall be apportioned as follows:

11 (1) Regional transportation projects  
12 (which shall be deemed to come from capital  
13 account funds available under section 211  
14 of the Compact of Free Association)

9 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 10-120, as amended by  
 10 Public Laws Nos. 10-122, 11-8, 11-10, 11-20, 11-32, 11-64, 11-75,  
 11 12-20, 12-47, and 12-68, is hereby further amended to read as  
 12 follows:

13 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
 14 date.

15 (1) All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
 16 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in  
 17 accordance with applicable law, including, but not  
 18 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
 19 allottee of the funds appropriated under section 1(3)(e)  
 20 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Chuuk  
 21 or his designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
 22 under section 1(2) of this act shall be the Speaker of  
 23 the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia. The  
 24 allottee of the funds appropriated under section 1(3)(a)  
 25 of this act shall be the Director of the Department of

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1 Health Services. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
2 under section 1(3)(c) of this act shall be the Assistant  
3 Director, Land Grant Program, Cooperative Extension  
4 Services, Chuuk State. The allottee of the funds  
5 appropriated under section 1(3)(d) of this act shall be  
6 the Executive Director of the Chuuk Recreation Office.  
7 The allottee of the funds appropriated under section  
8 1(3)(f) of this act shall be the Secretary of the  
9 Department of Health, Education and Social Affairs of  
10 the Federated States of Micronesia, or his designee.  
11 The allottee of the funds appropriated under sections  
12 1(5) and 1(3)(b) of this act shall be the Executive  
13 Director of the Northern Namoneas Development Authority,  
14 or if the Northern Namoneas Development Authority shall  
15 be abolished, the Northern Namoneas Project Coordinator  
16 or his designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
17 under sections 1(4) and 1(6)(b) of this act shall be the  
18 Executive Director of the Chuuk State Commission on  
19 Improvement Projects. At the beginning of each quarter,  
20 the Secretary of the Department of Finance and  
21 Administration, or his designee, shall provide a status  
22 report to the member of Congress representing Chuuk  
23 Election District No. 3 on the Educational and Health  
24 Trust Fund created pursuant to section 1(6)(b) of this  
25 act. Said report shall describe the investment status

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1 of the fund and changes in fund balances since the  
2 previous report, including nominal and real rates of  
3 return on investments. The allottee of the funds  
4 appropriated under section 1(6)(a) of this act shall be  
5 the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement Projects. The  
6 allottee of the funds appropriated under section 1(7) of  
7 this act shall be the Mayor of Polle. The allottee of  
8 the funds appropriated under section 1(8) of this act  
9 shall be the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement  
10 Projects. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
11 section 2(1) of this act shall be the respective mayor  
12 of each municipality listed therein. The allottee of  
13 the funds appropriated under sections 2(2) through 2(8)  
14 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of  
15 Kosrae. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
16 section 2(9) of this act shall be the President of the  
17 Federated States of Micronesia, or the President's  
18 designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
19 section 3(1)(a) of this act shall be the Mayor of  
20 Kolonia Town, and said allottee shall obligate no more  
21 than \$3,000 of such funds for administrative costs. The  
22 allottee of the funds  
23 appropriated under sections 4(1) through 4(7), 4(9)  
24 through 4(18), and 4(24) of this act shall be the  
25 Governor of the State of Yap. The allottee of the funds

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1           appropriated under section 4(8) of this act shall be the  
2           Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of  
3           Micronesia. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
4           under section 4(23) of this act shall be the Secretary  
5           of the Department of Health, Education and Social  
6           Affairs. The allottee of all other funds appropriated  
7           by this act  
8           shall be the President of the Federated States of  
9           Micronesia or the President's designee. In the event  
10          that the President designates the Vice President as  
11          allottee, the Vice President may designate a  
12          suballottee. The allottees shall be responsible for  
13          ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be  
14          necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in  
15          this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess  
16          of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds  
17          appropriated under section 3(2) of this act shall  
18          obligate no more than ten percent of such funds for  
19          administrative costs.

20               (2) The authority of the allottees to obligate funds  
21               appropriated by this act shall not lapse."  
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
