

AN ACT

To further amend sections 1 and 2 of Public Law No. 14-67, as amended, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein for Chuuk State At-Large, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 14-67, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 14-72, 14-82, 14-91, 14-101 and 15-06, is hereby
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$2.1 million, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006 for projects
8 and programs in each state of the Federated States of
9 Micronesia. The funds appropriated under section 1 of
10 this act shall be apportioned on the basis of \$150,000
11 per member of Congress as follows:

11 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 14-67, as amended by
12 Public Laws Nos. 14-72, 14-82 and 14-101, is hereby further
13 amended to read as follows:

14 "Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
15 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
16 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
17 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
18 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the
19 amended Compact of Free Association between the United
20 States Government and the Government of the Federated
21 States of Micronesia and its related agreements. The
22 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
23 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
24 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
25 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
26 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated

1 under subsections (4) (a), (c), (d) and (f) of section 1 of
2 this act shall be the Chuuk State Commission on
3 Improvement Project. The allottee of the funds
4 appropriated under subsection (4) (b) of section 1 of
5 this act shall be the Mortlocks Development Commission.
6 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
7 (4) (e) of section 1 of this act shall be the Mayor of
8 Polle. The allottee of funds appropriated under
9 subsections 1, 2 and 3 of Section 1 of this act shall be
10 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
11 except that the allottee of funds appropriated under
12 subsections (2) (b), (2) (c), 2(d) and (2) (f) of Section 1
13 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap.
14 The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
15 appropriated by this act shall lapse on 30 September
16 2008."

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18 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
19 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
20 becoming law without such approval.
