

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 15-11, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 15-18, 15-26 and 15-33, by amending sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8 and 9 thereof, in order to appropriate an additional \$727,537 from the General Fund for fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The title of Public Law No. 15-11, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 15-18, 15-26 and 15-33, is hereby further amended
3 to read as follows:

4 "To appropriate the sum of \$43,055,348 from the General
5 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
6 fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, for the purpose
7 of funding the operations of all branches of the
8 National Government of the Federated States of
9 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants,
10 subsidies and contributions and to establish a capital
11 and human resource development budget, and for other
12 purposes."

13 Section 2. Section 1 of Public Law No. 15-11, as amended by
14 Public Laws Nos. 15-18, 15-26 and 15-33, is hereby further amended
15 to read as follows:

16 "Section 1. The sum of \$43,055,348 from or so much
17 thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated from
18 the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia
19 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, for the
20 purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the
21 National Government of the Federated States of

1 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants,
2 subsidies and contributions and to establish a capital
3 and human resource development budget, and for other
4 purposes. The sum of appropriated herein shall be
5 apportioned as follows:"

6 Section 3. Section 2 of Public Law No. 15-11, as amended by
7 Public Laws Nos. 15-18, 15-26 and 15-33, is hereby further amended
8 to read as follows:

9 "Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch.
10 The sum of \$17,982,931 or so much thereof as may be
11 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
12 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
13 year ending September 30, 2008, for the purpose of
14 funding the operations of the Executive Branch of the
15 National Government during the fiscal year 2008. The
16 sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as
17 follows:
