PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-120

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 18-117, by amending sections 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people in each of the four states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 18-117 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 2. Of the sum of \$2,800,000 appropriated by
4 this act, \$400,000 is apportioned for Yap State for
5 public projects and social programs.

17 Section 6. Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-117 is hereby
18 amended to read as follows:

19 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
20 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
21 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
22 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
23 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
24 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
25 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used

1 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
2 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
3 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
4 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
5 State. The allottee of funds appropriated under
6 sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of
7 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee,
8 PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under
9 sections 3(a)(b)(c)(d)(e)(f)(g)(h)(i)(j)(k)(l) and (m)
10 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government; the allottee
11 of funds appropriation under sections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(f)
12 and 4(3)(j) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
13 Transportation Authority; the allottee of funds
14 appropriated under sections 4(3)(h), 4(3)(m) and 4(3)(o)
15 of this act shall be the Meninkeden Lapalap of
16 Madolenimw and the allottee of funds appropriated under
17 sections 4(3)(i), 4(3)(n) and 4(2)(p) of this act shall
18 be the Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti. The allottee of funds
19 appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(3) of section
20 5 of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or
21 his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
22 subsection 5(2) of section 5 of this act shall be the
23 Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The allottee of
24 funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of section 5 of
25 this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development

1 Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
2 subsection 5(5) of section 5 of this act shall be the
3 Faichuk Development Authority. The allottee of funds
4 appropriated under subsection 5(6) of this act shall be
5 the Northwest Island Development Authority. The
6 authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated
7 by this act to the States of Chuuk, Kosrae and Pohnpei
8 shall lapse on September 30, 2016. All funds
9 appropriated to Yap State that are not allotted by May
10 1, 2016, shall be deposited into the Yap State Trust
11 Fund. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
12 section 2 of this act for Yap State shall report proof
13 of deposit to Congress of the Federated States of
14 Micronesia within 30 days from depositing funds into the
15 Yap State Trust Fund.”

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1 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
3 law without such approval.
