PUBLIC LAW NO. 19-07

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-70, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-98, 18-112 and 18-122, by amending sections 3, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use, allottee and lapse date of certain funds previously appropriated for public projects and social programs for the people of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 18-70, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 18-98, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 3. Of the sum of \$5,100,000 appropriated by
4 this act, \$750,000 is apportioned for public projects
5 and social programs in the State of Kosrae.

3 Section 4. Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-70, as amended by
4 Public Laws Nos. 18-98, 18-112 and 18-122, is hereby further
5 amended to read as follows:

6 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
7 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
8 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
9 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
10 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
11 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
12 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
13 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
14 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
15 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
16 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
17 State EXCEPT THAT the funds appropriated under
18 subsection 2(i) shall be the President of COM-FSM. The
19 allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of
20 this act shall be the President of the Federated States
21 of Micronesia or his designee EXCEPT THAT the funds
22 appropriated under subsections a, b, c, d, e, f, g, h,
23 i, j, k, l, m, n, o, s, t, u, v, w, x and ag, ah, aj and
24 ap of section 3 this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town
25 Government or his designee; the funds appropriate under

1 subsection 4(2)(K) shall be the Mayor of Kolonia Town
2 Government; the funds appropriated under subsection
3 4(2)(m) shall be the Mayor of Nukuoro Municipal
4 Government; the funds appropriated under subsections a,
5 b, c, d, e, f and g of section 4(1), subsection 4(2)(1),
6 subsections 4(3)(b), (c), (d), (f) and (p) of this act
7 shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority, and the
8 funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(t) shall be the
9 Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti. The allottee of funds
10 appropriated under subsection 4(1)(h) shall be the
11 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
12 designee. The allottee of funds appropriate under
13 subsection 4(2)(g) of this act shall be the
14 Administrator of the MiCare program. The allottee of
15 funds appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6)
16 of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
17 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
18 subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock
19 Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds
20 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be
21 the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The
22 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of
23 this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority.
24 The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
25 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30,
