P.C. NO. 19-406 **PUBLIC LAW NO. 19-102**

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-117, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-120, 19-04, 19-08, 19-35, 19-49, 19-59 and 19-76, by amending sections 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use, lapse date and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of the states of Yap, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 18-117, as
2 amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-120, 19-04, 19-08 and 19-35,
3 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 ``Section 4. Of the sum of \$2,800,000 appropriated
5 by this act, \$800,000 is apportioned for Pohnpei

12 Section 4. Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-117, as amended
13 by Public Law 19-04 and 19-59, is hereby further amended to read
14 as follows:

15 ``Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and
16 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall
17 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
18 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
19 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
20 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
21 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
22 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
23 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
24 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
25 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of

1 Yap State; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
2 appropriated under subsection 2(i) shall be the
3 President of COM-FSM. The allottee of funds
4 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall
5 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
6 or his designee, PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
7 appropriated under sections
8 3(a) (b) (c) (d) (e) (f) (g) (h) (i) (j) (k) (l) and (m) shall be
9 the Mayor of Lelu Town Government; the allottee of funds
10 appropriation under sections 4(3) (a) and 4(3) (f) of
11 this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority;
12 the allottee of funds appropriated under section
13 4(3) (h) of this act shall be the Meninkeden Lapalap of
14 Madolenimw and the allottee of funds appropriated under
15 section 4(3) (i) of this act shall be the Luhkenmoanlap
16 of Kitti. The allottee of funds appropriated under
17 subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of section 5 of this
18 act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
19 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
20 subsection 5(2) of section 5 of this act shall be the
21 Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The allottee
22 of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of section
23 5 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas
24 Development Authority. The allottee of funds
25 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of section 5 of this

1 act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The
2 authority of the allottee to obligate funds
3 appropriated by this act to the states of Yap, Chuuk,
4 Kosrae and Pohnpei shall lapse on September 30, 2017.”

5 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by
6 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon
7 its becoming law without such approval.
