SECOND CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA Public Law No. 2-49

THIRD REGULAR SESSION, 1982 CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 2-255, C.D.1

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$1,356,200 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia, the sum of \$3,142,114.94 from the United States Grant Special Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1983, for the operations of the executive branch, legislative branch, National judiciary, Public Auditor, agencies of the National Government, and for United States Federal programs, special programs, contributions, grants, and subsidies of the National Government during fiscal year 1983; to establish employment ceilings; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Operating expenses of the executive branch, United States 2 Federal program expenses of the executive branch and State grants, and 3 United Nations State grants. The sum of \$610,400, or so much thereof as may 4 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated 5 States of Micronesia, and the sum of \$2,919,396.94, or so much thereof as 6 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the United States Grant 7 Special Fund, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1983, for operations of the 8 9 executive branch, United States Federal program expenses of the executive branch and State grants, and United Nations State grants during fiscal year 10 1983. All funds 5 appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered, and 6 accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited 7 8 to the Financial Management Act of 1979, as amended, and United States 9 Federal program enabling acts. The allottee shall be responsible for 10 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used 11 solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are 12 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottee 13 to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 14 1983. 15 Section 10. Effective date. This act shall become law upon approval by
