24 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 4-22 is hereby amended to  
25 read as follows:

1           "Section 2. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
2           allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in  
3           accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited  
4           to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee  
5           shall be the Governor of Pohnpei State for all the appro-  
6           priations herein, except that the Pohnpei Community Action  
7           Agency shall be the allottee for appropriations under  
8           subsection (1) of section 1, the Luhken Menlap of the Kitti  
9           municipal government shall be the allottee for appropriations  
10          under subsection (2)(a) of section 1, the Menin Keder lapalap  
11          of the Madolenihmw municipal government shall be the allottee  
12          for appropriations under subsection (2)(b) of section 1, and  
13          the chief magistrate of the Sokehs municipal government  
14          shall be the allottee for appropriations under subsection  
15          (3)(b) of section 1. The allottees shall be responsible for  
16          ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be  
17          necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in  
18          this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of  
19          the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottees to  
20          obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of  
21          September 30, 1986."

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1 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming  
3 law without such approval.
