New Section 1A

"Constitutional "IA. This Ordinance shall be read subject to provision, the provisions of Part I of Chapter 7 of the Constitution.".

Section 2

Insert before the definition "council" -

"'candidate: means a person substitting himself, in accordance with this Ordinance, for election as a member of the Maneaba ni Maungulabu or of a Council;",

Insert after the definition "election" -

"'election patition' means an application under section 60 of the Constitution or under section 34:".

"lelector' means a person who is entitled to vote -

"(2) Subject to any directions of the Electoral Commission under the powers conferred by section 63(1) of the Constitution, the Chief Electoral Officer may, if he thinks it expedient to do so, perform any function under this Ordinance of an Electoral Officer in relation to the election of a number of the Meneaba ni Maungatabu.".

- "(2) A person who is tegistered as an elector is entitled -
 - (a) to vote at an election of a member of the Manesba ni. Moungatabu for the elections district in which he is registered; and
 - (b) where the ward in respect of which he is registered comprises or forms part of the area of authority of a council to vote at an election of a member of the council for that ward."

- (b) in the case of an election of a member of a council by -
 - (i) a person who had a right to vote at the election; or
 - (ii) a person who claims to have hed a right to be returned or elected at the election; or
 - (iii) a person who claims that he was a condidate at the election.".
