TO MAKE FURTHER PROVISIONS FOR AMENDMENTS TO CERTAIN ORDINANCES CONSEQUENTIAL UPON THE ENACTMENT OF THE MAGISTRATES COURT ORDINANCE 1977

Commencement: 29th September, 1978

ENACTED by the Governor with the advice and consent of the House of Assembly:-

Short title

This Ordinance may be cited as the Magistrates Courts (Consequential Amendments) Ordinance 1978.

2. The Ordinances set out in the first column of the Schedule shall be amended to the extent set out in the second column of the Schedule.

IRST COLUMN A

Deportation (Immigrant British subject) Ordinance (Cap 79) [1]

Criminal Procedure Code (Cap. 7)

Rent Review Ordinance ᅒ (No: 10 of 1974)

SECOND COLUMN

The Ordinance shall have affect as if for the words "Senior Magistrate" wherever those words occur there were substituted the words "High Court"

Section 67 is amended in subsection (1) by inserting after paragraph (iii) the following:

"(iv) that any particular criminal case or class of cases be transferred from a Magistrates! Court to the High Court".

Section 5 is amended by repealing the words "the Lands Courts Appeal Panel" wherever they appear and substituting the words "a Magistra-tes' Court".

Section 6 is repealed.

Section 7 is amended by repealing the words "the Lands Courts Appeals Panel" and substituting the words "a Magistrates' Court".

Native Lands (Amendment)

Ordinance (No. 19 of 1977)

At the end of the proviso to section 5 (wh. ... relates to the saving of jurisdiction of the Lands Courts Appeals Panel) the following proviso should be added:

"And provided that an appeal to the High Court shall lie against any determination of the Lands Courts Appeals Panel in accordance with the provisions of section 25, and the High Court, for the purposes of this section shall comprise the Chief Justice or a Judge sitting alone".
