AN ACT TO AUTHORISE SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION OF MONIES
OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND FOR RECURRENT EXPENDITURE
FOR THE SERVICE OF THE YEAR ENDING 31 DECEMBER, 1980.

Commencement: 27 August, 1980.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act, 1980.

Authorisation of
issue of \$196,318
from the Conso-
lidated Fund.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of \$196,318 to be applied for recurrent expenditure to the service of the year ending on 31 December, 1980.

Appropriation.

3. The sum specified in section 2 shall be appropriated for the supply of the Head of Expenditure specified in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed to this Act in the sums respectively specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the Schedule.



SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION ACT, 1980.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

1. This Bill charges upon the Consolidated Fund a sum which is required for recurrent expenditure for the year ending 31 December 1980, in addition to the amount appropriated for that year by the Appropriation Act, 1979.
2. The sum required is to provide for monies expended in excess of sums already appropriated.
3. The Bill provides that the additional amount charged shall be divided between and expended upon the services listed in the Schedule to the Bill.
4. The Bill is presented to the Maneaba ni Maungatabu in accordance with the requirements of section 109(3) of the Constitution.
