§201. Short title.

This Act may be cited as the “Vehicle (Right-hand Drive) Act 1984”. [P.L. 1984-15]

§202. Import restriction.

(1) Subject to Section 203 of this Act, no person may import any land-operated right-hand drive motor vehicle.

(2) Land-operated right-hand drive motor vehicles imported or attempted to be imported in contravention of Subsection (1) of this Section are prohibited imports within the meaning of any law relating to the import of goods. §203. Government import, etc.

Notwithstanding Section 202(1) of this Act, the Government of the Marshall Islands may import a vehicle if the Minister determines that the purpose of importation is for a Government of the Marshall Islands public works function and that no left-hand drive vehicles for such purpose are available. As used herein, “Minister” means the Minister responsible for the subject matter of this Act. [P.L. 1984-15,§ 4.][formerly numbered as §204, see annotation under §202 above[Rev2003]
