## THE ISLAND OF NAURU

## No. 2 of 1954. AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Census Ordinance 1947.

BE it ordained by the Administrator of the Island of Nauru acting in pursuance of the powers conferred by Article 1 of the Agreement dated the second day of July, 1919, between the Government of the United Kingdom, the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia and the Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, as follows:-

Short title and citation.

 $1_{\bullet}$  (1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the <u>Census Ordinance</u> 1954.

(2.) The <u>Census Ordinance</u> 1947, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the <u>Census Ordinance</u> 1947-1954.

Particulars to be included in the Schedule.

- 2. Section twenty-one of the <u>Census Ordinance</u> 1947 is amended by omitting paragraphs (a) and (b) and by inserting the following paragraphs in their stead:-
  - "(a) in relation to the dwelling -
    - (i) Class of dwelling;
    - (ii) Material of which outer walls are built;
    - (iii) Number of rooms;
    - (iv) Occupancy;
    - (v) Weekly rent;
    - (vi) Facilities;
    - (vii) Date of building;
    - (viii) Farm dwellings;
  - (b) in relation to each person resident in the

dwelling or employed or travelling on the ship -

- (i) Name;
- (ii) Relation to head of household;
- (iii) Sex;
- (iv) Age;
- (v) Particulars as to marriage;
- (vi) Religion;
- (vii) Birthplace;
- (viii) Period of residence in the Territory;
  - (ix) Nationality;

(x) Race;

- (x1) Persons not engaged in an industry, business, profession, trade or service;
- (xii) Unemployment;
- (xiii) Particulars of grade, occupation and industry;

## (xiv) Place of work.
