A N O R D I N A N C E

To amend the Customs Regulations Ordinance 1922.

I, the Administrator of the Island of Nauru, do hereby enact order and proclaim as under :-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Regulations Amendment Ordinance 1936 and shall be deemed to have come into operation as from 1st January 1936.

2. The Customs Regulations Ordinance 1922 is in this Ordinance referred to as the principal Ordinance.

3. The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Regulations Ordinance 1922-1936.

4. By this Ordinance the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words "fifteen per cent" in paragraph (1) under EXCEPTIONS and inserting in their stead the words "five per cent".
