AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Customs Regulations Ordinance 1922.

- I, the Administrator of the Island of Nauru, do hereby enact order and proclaim as under :-
- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the <u>Customs Regulations</u>

 <u>Amendment Ordinance</u> 1936 and shall be deemed to have come into operation as from 1st January 1936.
- 2. The Customs Regulations Ordinance 1922 is in this Ordinance referred to as the principal Ordinance.
- 3. The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the <u>Gustoms Regulations Ordinance</u> 1922-1936.
- 4. By this Ordinance the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words "fifteen per cent" in paragraph (1) under EXCEPTIONS and inserting in their stead the words "five per cent".
