To amend the Customs Tariff Ordinance 1937-1959.

CUSTOMS TARIFF ORDINANCE 1965

Short title
and citation.

1.- (1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Tariff Ordinance 1965.

(2.) The Customs Tariff Ordinance 1937-1959,* as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Customs Tariff Ordinance 1937-1965.

Commencement.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on the fourteenth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-six.

The Schedule.

3. The Schedule to the Customs Tariff Ordinance 1937-1959 is repealed and the following Schedule inserted in its stead:

4. Duties of Customs in accordance with the Customs Tariff Ordinance 1937-1959, as amended by this Ordinance, shall be charged and collected on goods imported into Nauru on or after the date of commencement of this Ordinance.
