AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Laws Repeal and Adopting Ordinance 1922-1936

- I, the Administrator of the Island of Nauru, do hereby enact, order and proclaim as under :-
- 1. -(a) This Ordinance may be cited as the Laws Repeal and Adopting Ordinance No.2 of 1936, and shall come into operation forthwith.
- (b) The Laws Repeal and Adopting Ordinance 1922-1936, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (c) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the Laws Repeal and Adopting Ordinance 1922-1936 No.2.
- 2. The OATHS ORDINANCE 1912, referred to in the Third Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting in Subsection 1 of Section 38, after the word "necessary", the words "for any place in Nauru or elsewhere", and after the word "affidavits" the words "in that place"; and by inserting in Section 39, after the word "shall", the words "unless otherwise directed in Commission".
