AN ORDINANCE

To amend the <u>Caths Ordinance</u> 1912 - 1937

BE it ordained by the Administrator of the Island of

Nauru in pursuance of the powers conferred by Article

1 of the Agreement dated the second day of July, 1919,

between His Majesty's Government in London, His

Majesty's Government of the Commonwealth of Australia

and His Majesty's Government of the Dominion of New

Zealand, as follows:-

- 1. (1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the <u>Oaths</u>
 Ordinance 1949.
- (2.) The <u>Oaths Ordinance</u> 1912-1937 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal rdinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the Oaths Ordinance 1912-1949.
- 2. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after sub-section (2.) the following sub-section:-
 - "(3.) Such oath shall be tendered and taken before the Administrator or a Judge or Magistrate of the Central Court."
