AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Public Health Ordinance 1925

- I, the Administrator of the Island of Nauru, do hereby enact, order and proclaim as under :-
- 1. -(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the <u>Public Health</u> Ordinance 1936.
- (2). The Public Health Ordinance 1925, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3). The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the <u>Public Health Ordinance</u> 1925-1936.
- 2. After section three of the Principal Ordinance the following sections are inserted:-
 - "3A. In this Ordinance, unless the contrary intention appears -
 - 'Close settlement area' means any area declared by the Administrator by notice in the <u>Gazette</u> to be a close Settlement;
 - 'Stock' includes any pig.
 - "3B. The Government Medical Officer shall, as directed by the Administrator, make an inspection of any close settlement area, and furnish a written report thereon.
 - "3C. The Administrator, upon receiving a report from the Government Medical Officer, may, by notice, require any holder of a leasehold in a close settlement area to take such measures as the Administrator thinks fit, for the exclusion of stock from any close settlement area.
 - "5D. Any leaseholder who fails to comply with the notice referred to in the last preceding section shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding Two pounds.".
