THE REPUBLIC OF NAURU (No.4 of 1968)

AN ACT

To amend the Public Service Ordinance 1961-1967 (Certified 14/6/1963)

Be it enacted by the Parliament of Nauru as follows:-

- Short Title 1.-(1.) This Act may be cited as the <u>Public Service</u> and Citation. <u>Act</u> 1968.
 - (2.) The <u>Public Service Ordinance</u> 1961-1967 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
 - (3.) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Act may be cited as the <u>Public Service Act</u> 1961-1968.
- Commence- 2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation ment.

 on the thirty first day of January, 1968.
- Absence for Certain Officers.

 The Public Service Commissioner shall be deemed to have granted leave of absence with salary, without deduction from leave of absence for recreation, to an officer who was -
 - (a) a Member of the Council of State, for the purpose of his attendance to the business of the Council of State; or
 - (b) a Member of the Legislative Assembly, for the purpose of his attendance to the business of the Legislative Assembly.
 - 4. Section 57 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting paragraphs (a) and (b) of sub-section (1.) and by inserting in their place the following paragraph:-
 - "(a) Parliament, for the purpose of his attendance to the business of the Parliament; or".
