PUBLIC SERVICE ORDINANCE 1962

Short title and citation

- 1.-(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the <u>Public</u>

 <u>Service Ordinance</u> 1962
- (2.) The <u>Public Service Ordinance</u> 1961 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the <u>Public Service Ordinance</u> 1961-1962.

Commencement

2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-one.

Public Service Commissioner

- 3. Section nine of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (3.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-section:-
- "(3.) The Commissioner shall be paid such salary (if any), allowances (if any) and expenses (if any) as the Minister determines.".

Acting Commissioner.

- 4. Section ten of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (3.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-section:-
- "(3.) A person appointed under this section shall be paid such salary (if any), allowances (if any) and expenses (if any) as the Minister determines.".

Holidays.

- 5. Section forty-four of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (1.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-section:-
- "(1.) Subject to this section, the following days are holidays in the Public Service:-

The first day of January.

The anniversary of the return of Nauruans from the Caroline Islands after the war which commenced on the third day of September, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine, that is to say, the thirty-first day of January.

Good Friday and the following Saturday, Monday and Tuesday.

Anzac Day, that is to say, the twenty-fifth day of April.

Angam Day, that is to say, the twenty-sixth day of October.

Occupation Day, that is to say, the sixth day of November.

The anniversary of the Birthday of the Sovereign.
Christmas Day and the following day.".

Recreational Leave.

6. Section forty-five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (1.) the words "twelve days" and inserting in their stead the words "eighteen days".
