**AN ACT**

***To provide for the withdrawal of additional moneys from the Treasury Fund for the services of the Republic for the financial year ending the Thirtieth day of June One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three and to amend the Finance Act 1972-1973***

***(Certified: 10th May, 1973)***

***Enacted by the Parliament of Nauru as follows:***

**SHORT TITLE**

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Finance Act 1972-1973.

**WITHDRAWAL OF MONEYS FROM THE TREASURY FUND**

2. (1) The amount of Four Hundred and Thirty Thousand, Four Hundred Dollars (\$430,400) may be withdrawn from the Treasury Fund and expended in the manner specified in the Schedule of this Act for the services of the Republic during the financial year ending on the Thirtieth Day of June, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.
- (2) The amount authorised by this section to be withdrawn from the Treasury Fund and expended is additional to, and not in substitution for, the amounts authorised to be withdrawn from the Treasury Fund and expended by the Finance Act 1972-1973.
- (3) Where Cabinet considers it necessary to alter the amount assigned in the Schedule to a particular account within a Department, the Cabinet may direct that there shall be applied to the aid of that account a further sum out of any surplus arising on other accounts within the same Department and the Schedule shall be deemed to have been varied accordingly with effect from the commencement of this Act, provided that when Cabinet authorises a transfer of funds within a Department in accordance with this subsection it shall cause to be laid before Parliament at the first meeting of Parliament after it has approved the transfer a copy of the order of the Cabinet approving such transfer.

**AMENDMENT OF THE FINANCE ACT 1972-1973**

3. (1) Subsection (1) of Section 2 of the Finance Act 1972-1973 is amended by deleting the words "Schedules One and Two" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "The First and Second Schedules".
- (2) Subsection (2) of Section 2 of the Finance Act 1972-1973 is amended by-
  - (a) deleting the words "a Schedule" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "the First Schedule", and
  - (b) deleting the words "the Schedule" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "the First Schedule".
- (3) Subsection (3) of Section 2 of the Finance Act 1972-1973 is amended by-
  - (a) deleting the words "Sub-section 1 of this Section" and inserting in

lieu thereof the words "subsection (1)" and

(b) adding at the end thereof the words "as specified in the Second Schedule."

(4) Section 2 of the Finance Act 1972-1973 is amended by adding the following new subsection (4):

"(4) For the purpose of subsection (3) a liability to pay for goods or services supplied to the Republic is to be deemed to have been incurred at the time when an order for the supply of such goods or services was signed."

#### **NAURU HOUSING FUND**

4. Where moneys are withdrawn from the Treasury Fund and expended in accordance with the Schedule for the erection, maintenance and repair of Nauru Housing, the Treasury Fund shall be reimbursed from the Nauru Housing Fund to the extent of that expenditure and the Nauru Housing Fund is charged accordingly.
